Per Treasurer, there's \$10,000 in reserves. For now HOA dues will remain at \$250.

Downstairs bathroom - Remodeling is complete.

Miscellaneous – Furnace was repaired, cable service was cancelled, internet remains. A rail around the playground will be installed and mulch added.

Ms. Hass from 108 Grapevine Road, suggested re-instating kids events, like Halloween parade, Super Bowl, movies, etc. Some of these activities were cancelled due to lack of support or to Covid.
